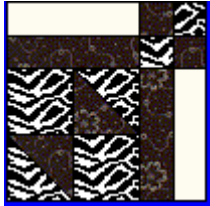


ROUGE VALLEY QUILTERS' GUILD – BLOCK OF THE MONTH  
MARCH 2008 – ODDS AND ENDS



SIZE: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" UNFINISHED

FABRICS:

A – DARK (White on black) print. One square (5 3/8" X 5 3/8")  
Two squares (2" X 2")  
Two strips (9 1/2" X 2")

B- LIGHT (Black on white) print. One square (5 3/8" X 5 3/8")  
Two squares (5" X 5")  
Two squares (2" X 2")

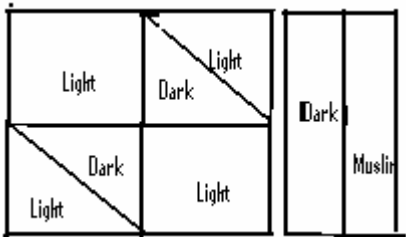
C –Muslin, ecology cloth or off white. Two strips (9 1/2" X 2")

1. Make two half square triangles by placing the two 5 3/8" squares (one dark, one light) right sides together. Draw a diagonal from corner to corner and sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides. Cut apart on the diagonal and press towards the dark fabric. Trim points.

2. Make a four patch with the two light 5" squares and the two half square triangles as shown below.

3. Add a dark strip (9 1/2" X 2") and a muslin strip (9 1/2" X 2") to the right hand side of the block as shown.

Press seams towards the dark fabric.



4. Add the 2" dark and light squares to the 9 1/2" X 2" dark and muslin strips. Press and add this block to the TOP of the block as shown at the top of the page.

Muslin	Dark	Light
Dark	Light	Dark

Press finished work (block should measure 12 ½"square).
